For families with complex needs who live in Southwark and meet the following criteria:

Essential:

- Unemployed and eligible to work in the UK
- Parents or young person 16+ (part of a family)

And one of these:

- Parents or children involved in crime or anti-social behaviour.
- Parents or children with a range of health conditions
- Parents with children who don't attend or have low school attendance
- Children who are identified as subject to a care plan or social care intervention
- Families affected by domestic abuse and violence
- Adults out of work and at risk of financial exclusion

Our advisers offer:

- Home visits if required
- Referrals to basic training, CV and interview workshops
- Benefit support
- Job search support
- Travel to work and interview clothing expenses
- Childcare deposit once into work
- Attend team meetings, coffee morning sessions on Universal Credit and about our programme
