

#### Our Learning Journey

- In literacy we have continued looking at the Tin Forest and have predicted what the forest may look like after the birds have dropped their seeds. We also imagined what the old man would see as he walked through the forest and how he would feel knowing that he had created it.
- In maths we have been finding unit fractions of amounts by using our times tables knowledge to divide the fraction by the denominator.
- We have continued with our geography topic by looking at pictures of the New Forest and having our trip to Sydenham woods to create our own tin forest.

#### Our Home Learning

**Reading:** We would like the children to be reading every day. Reading books are changed on Thursdays and library books are changed on Mondays.

**Spelling:** The spellings this week are on homophones.

**Maths:** The children should continue practising their 2, 3, 5- and 10-times tables. We will be looking at time next week so can you practise telling the time to o'clock, a quarter past and a quarter to.
