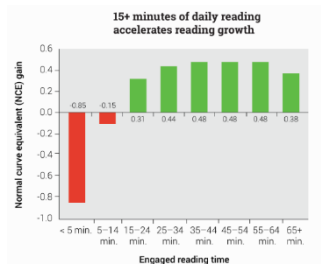


Our Learning Journey
