

Our Learning Journey

- Thank you to all the parents who attended the learning review meetings this week. It was a fantastic opportunity to meet face to face and discuss all the wonderful work and achievements from this half term.
- This week in literacy we have continued reading our story, Escape from Pompeii. We have written letters in response to a newspaper article by a Roman Senator and argued that Mount Vesuvius is a dangerous volcano. We have also begun to write our own dialogue for the two main characters.
- In maths this week, we have been learning about length. We have practised measuring different objects around the classroom and have been converting between centimetres and millimetres.

Our Home Learning

Reading: All children are expected to read at least 20 minutes a day. Please encourage them to read with you and engage them by asking questions about the text.

Spelling: Year 3 have been given new spellings to learn- they are expected to practise these on the sheet and complete the activity on the back.

Maths: We will be learning about perimeter as well as interpreting information from pictograms and bar graphs. Please encourage the children to research what a bar graph is as an introduction to the topic.

Learning Log: The home learning task this week is to research volcanic eruptions. This relates to our literacy work and will give the children a deeper understanding of what our main characters might be experiencing. Their learning logs are due back on the last day of term, Thursday 19th December 2019.
