We are now focussing on consolidating all the sounds we have learned, and practising blending for reading and segmenting for spelling. Please practice all of the phase 3 sounds and read regularly with your child. Please practice the tricky words 'like' and 'was'.
- **Weekend Challenge** – Draw a picture of what you saw on the trip to China Town. It could be your favourite thing or lots of things! You could even use your phonics to label the picture!


