Learning Journey: A day in the Life of...

Our Learning Journey

There was breaking news at the beginning of the week that the moon had disappeared! The children discussed whether they had seen it recently and possible reasons as to where it was. They created missing posters to help recover the moon by using adjectives to describe it.

The children have been creating timelines and thinking about different stages in their lives to link to our history topic. They have been learning about the first moon landing, role playing what it might have been like.

In maths we have been practicing writing numbers in words to 10 and above, counting to 50 and above from any number, using ordinal numbers to 10, and finding 1 more/less of a number. They have been reasoning about number and using mathematical vocabulary to explain their answer, e.g. Sam counts on in ones from eighteen- 18, 19, 20, 21, 23. What mistake did Sam make? How do you know?

Home Learning

A new Learning Log sheet and spelling activity will be given out to each child today. Please complete these at home and continue listening to your child read.

Maths: Practice writing numbers in words to 10 and above.

Have a race or competition with your favourite activity. Can you record where everyone came using ordinal numbers?
