Learning Journey: A day in the Life of...

### Our Learning Journey

This week, we have been learning about how astronauts eat in space. In DT, we looked at existing space food products and asked children which ingredients they would enjoy the most by conducting a simple survey. We then designed a space food product and made space sandwiches using healthy ingredients.

In literacy, we are still reading Sidney, Stella and the Moon. We created non-fiction sentences about the moon and identified the features of existing non-fiction texts.

In maths, we have been consolidating addition. Some of us are using an empty number line to add and some are using mental counting on as a strategy for addition. We used these methods to help us solve word problems, some of us looking at missing number problems as well.

In phonics, we have been consolidating phase 5 sounds and learning alternative pronuniations for ie and ea.

### Home Learning

Thank you to all the Year 1 children for sharing your heritage boxes! They have all been absolutely fantastic and we have really enjoyed learning about each other.

Please develop your maths at home by practising counting on **starting from any number**. For example, 'Let's start counting from 12!' or 'Let's start counting from 29!' (crossing the tens boundary can be tricky for Year 1 children so this is a useful thing to practise).

Please continue to practise your spelling words each week and read for 10 minutes every day.

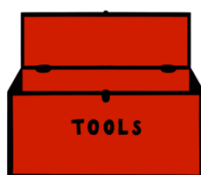
