This week we have been writing our own version of 'Jim and the Beanstalk'. We have included fronted adverbials and expanded noun phrases. Some children even included speech and inverted commas. We have been trying to choose more exciting 'green' words and leave the boring 'red' words out in our traffic light system. In maths we have revisited number to practise ordering numbers, placing numbers on number lines and solve reasoning problems where we explain our knowledge.

In whole class reading we have started a new book called 'Rabbit & Bear' by Julian Gough and Jim Field. We made predications about the nature of the characters and explored language choice of the authors.

On Friday afternoon we had a special visit from a nurse in order to find out what it is like to work as a nurse. In preparation for this the children wrote some fantastic questions to ask ensuring they started with a capital letter and ended with a full stop.
