Learning Journey: A day in the Life of...

Our Learning Journey

- This week the children were immersed and introduced to the new topic for this term 'A day in the Life of...' Year 5 will be exploring the life of two extremely influential and important people in history; Katherine Johnson and Harriet Tubman. During history, the children looked at a heritage pack which was filled with all kinds of clues linking to a mystery historical person. The children devised questions and used their making links tools to decipher who the person could be.
- In Literacy, the children used their imagination tool and joined the NASA workstation team. We created non-fiction reports for the NASA website by linking facts and using conjunctions and adverbs to express our ideas.
- In maths, the children looked at measurement and used their reasoning tools in order to contextualise real life examples. They looked at various examples of mass and capacity.
- In reading we started our new class book "The Tiger Rising" by Kate DiCamillo. This book follows the journey of a young boy Rob who one day finds a tiger locked in a cage in the woods. Rob meets a few interesting characters along the way and begins to experience a transformative journey of self discovery.

Home Learning

The children are expected to read for at least 20 minutes per day. This doesn't just relate to story books it can be reading of any kind. Please encourage children to read with you at home and ask them questions to engage with.

This week learning log is about the children creating their own heritage box. The children have also been given a new spelling rule and worksheet to complete.
