## Learning Journey: A day in the Life of...

### Our Learning Journey

This week we have continued to learn about the Suffragettes. The children learnt about a lady called Chrystabel Pankhurst who was a member of the WSPU and fought hard for women's rights. The children used their empathy goggles to imagine what it would have been like for Chrystabel. They wrote their own diaries exploring the events that occurred leading up to Chrystabel being sent to prison. They thought carefully about how she would have been feeling and the impact that the events would have had.

In maths we have been consolidating our understanding of division through securing both the short and long methods. They thought carefully about what they might need to know to help them solve their problems efficiently. The children then demonstrated that they can apply these skills to a range of reasoning style problems.

In History, we have continued to explore the changing role of women throughout time. We explored the significant impact that WWI had on women and their rights and considered how they help to shape women's lives today. The children have thoroughly enjoyed exploring the changing role of women.

### Home Learning

Over the next two weeks the children have been asked to create their own heritage boxes for their learning logs. It will be great to share them in class!


