Learning Journey: A day in the Life of...

### Our Learning Journey

In maths this week we have been looking at teen numbers up to 13. The children have been using tens frames to deepen their understanding of the tens and ones and how to partition bigger numbers.

In literacy we have been exploring the text *Little Red*; a twist on the traditional tale *Little Red Riding Hood*. The children have loved getting to know the different characters and we have been focusing on character voice and looking at how speech bubbles are used in texts. Lots of the children have been excited about making warning signs for Little Red to warn him of the ferocious wolf!

In phonics we have been working on 'building a sentence' and encouraging the children to think about whether all the word sounds have been included.

### Home Learning

As we have been developing our storytelling skills, this weekend please encourage your child to tell you a story and support them in putting their story into writing. If you feel your child can write certain words, encourage them to have a go at writing these and collaborate together to write their story down. We will be sharing their stories and acting them out next week.

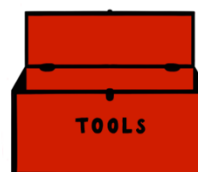
