This week the children have been working really hard on their mock SATS. Well done everyone, we are really proud! Keep up the hard work, and continue encouraging your children to revise any areas they might find more challenging.

In literacy, the children learned about the life of Emily Davidson (a member of the WSPU) and the tragic event that happened to her at Epsom Downs. The children used their planning tool to plan their own newspaper articles to report the incidents that happened. They focused on using a range of formal language features including passive voice.

In History, we continued to learn about the role of women, this time focusing on the strike that occurred at Ford Dagenham in the late 60s and the impact that had on women's pay and the equal pay act. The children have been very passionate in learning about the role of women over time.

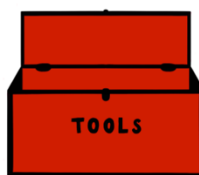
