Learning Journey: A day in the Life of...

Our Learning Journey

To conclude our whole school learning journey 'A day in the life of...' the children carried out research about a particular woman that a significant impact on how our lives are today. The children then created power point presentations using google slides and presented them to the class thinking carefully about their speaking and listening skills.

In literacy, we explored the question 'Should the Suffragettes have used violence?'. After having a discussion surrounding this, weighing up the pros and cons, the children planned and wrote their own balanced argument considering how to appear unbiased and acknowledge both sides of the argument.

In maths we explored the properties of 2D and 3D shapes ensure we were using the correct terminology. The children then explored the angles in a triangle and solved a range of problems applying their reasoning skills.

Over the next two weeks the children have been asked to design and create their own theatre inspired by the Glove to link with our up and coming learning journey.
