

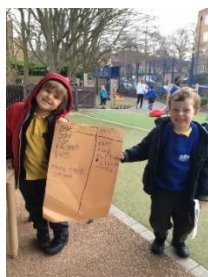

Learning Journey: All the World's a Stage!

Our Learning Journey



This week we have continued the children's interest in animals and pets with a visit to the Guinea Pigs and preparing to make our own information video about how to look after them. We all wrote our own speech information sentences to read. The Pet Shop and Vet role play areas have been very popular and we were very lucky to have a parent come in to tell us all about the rescue dog and cat they own. We are very excited to have a real dog come in on Monday!



In maths, we learned about patterns, looking at patterns around us and repeating patterns. We made our own patterns using sound and objects. We have also moved on to learning about 'teen' numbers and how to partition them into ten and ones, with the help of the Number Blocks!

Home Learning

Please help your child to think of a **question** they would like to ask about having a pet dog for our visitor on Monday!

In maths, we will be learning about time next week, sequencing familiar events and using language related to this. Talk to your child about what you did yesterday, what you are going to do tomorrow and encourage them to sequence their daily events verbally.

In phonics, we are really focussing on recognising those tricky words when reading. We have given each child a copy of the tricky words for phase 3, which we have already learned, and phase 4, which need to be learned by the end of Reception.
