### Our Learning Journey

Reception have had a fantastic week this week. The children were so excited about our trip to Battersea Park Zoo and decided to write some questions beforehand to take with them and be answered by the 'animal experts'. The trip was a real success with a lot of learning taking place, thank you to the parents who came along to help!

To link with our topic of animals, we have been reading 'The Great Pet Sale'. In maths we have been exploring money and becoming more familiar with different coin denominations. We have seen some brilliant discussions in the Dulwich Wood Pet Shop and the children have loved creating price tags and labels for different animals.

In phonics we have been working on 'building a sentence', using our 'Think it, say it, write it, check it' rule. We have also been practicing recognising the tricky words: *they, are, like* and *so*.

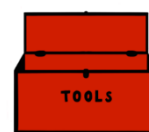
We had a great World Book Day and the children loved dressing up as their favourite book characters and sharing their story with the rest of the class.
