Coronavirus: reminder of required closure

Dear Parents/Carers,

Re: Coronavirus update – reminder of school closure to most pupils

I'm writing to remind you that school will be closed to almost all children **from Monday morning until further notice.**

While we regret that this is the situation, we have to follow the latest government advice.

Therefore, we do not expect to see your children on Monday unless:

- Any parent or carer in your household is a critical worker and **you won't be able to care for your child or children at home.** (See who counts as a critical worker [here.](#))
- They have an education, health and care plan and **you won't be able to care for your child or children at home.**
- They have a child protection plan and **you won't be able to care for your child or children at home.**

This is emergency childcare provision, and if children can be left at home safely because there is adequate care then this is what MUST happen. We are trying to reduce the spread of COVID-19, whilst at the same time support our families with critical workers.

If your child falls into one of the categories above and you haven't already emailed Miss Rowe the information form, please let us know immediately by emailing Miss Rowe hrowe@dulwichwood.com

If we are not expecting to see your child on Monday morning, we will need to send them home.

Pupils who receive free school meals

If your child receives free school meals but isn't eligible to attend school from Monday, we can help make alternative provision for you. We will contact you by Tuesday to make you aware of these arrangements.

Home Learning

- Year 1 – Year 6: keep working on your pack that we sent home, check the website too! If you haven't collected your pack please contact the office to arrange collection.

I know this is a difficult time for many of you, and the next few weeks will be an adjustment for all of us. We are doing everything we can to support your children and families at this time and appreciate your patience and support. Please do help us by following the advice set out above.
