<p>LO: To write a book review</p> <p>Choose one of the books you are reading at home and write a short review, explaining what you liked/disliked and who you would recommend the book to.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I can use 'because' to extend my sentences • I can use a capital letter and full stop • I can give my opinion
<p>LO: To orally tell a story</p> <p>Create a puppet show! Choose your favourite toys to be your cast members and create a story which you can perform to your family. Can you change your voice to show different characters?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I can speak clearly so others can hear me • I can invent a story with a beginning, middle and ending
<p>LO: To write labels and lists</p> <p>Can you 'noun' the items in your house? You could organise your toys, write a list of what you have and write labels for each one. You could make picture labels for cupboard doors or drawers and make signs reminding everyone to put things away in the right place!</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I can use a capital letter and full stop • I can use phonics to write words
<p>LO: To write instructions</p> <p>Do some cooking! Can you write a recipe for what you have made?</p> <p>You could also invent a game and write instructions so that others know how to play.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I can use bossy verbs • I can write commands • I can include a you-will-need list and handy tips
<p>LO: To write a letter</p> <p>Write a letter to someone you really admire. It could be someone you know, or it could be someone famous such as an author, a singer, or even the queen!</p> <p>You could also make an envelope to put the letter in.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I can use a capital letter and full stop • I can use phonics to write words
