Learning Journey: All the World's a Stage!

Our Learning Journey

We have been learning to measure weight and capacity this week. The children have been comparing the weight of different items using the vocabulary heavier, lighter and equal to balance. They have been using balance scales to find the weight of items in the classroom using cubes. They have been estimating and measuring to find the correct weight in cubes.

The children have been comparing the capacity of containers using full, empty and half full. They have been measuring how much water a container can hold using cups as a measurement.

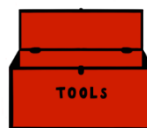
We have been continuing to explore 'The Tempest' this week. The children have made maps of the island and thought about the adjectives they would use to describe what they might see, feel, hear and smell whilst walking around the island. They wrote a letter to Prospero persuading him to forgive and be kinder to others and not continue to seek revenge.

They have learnt more about Caliban's story on the island and how he has been treated by Prospero. The children explore the emotions of the characters through the four elements: Water, Air, Fire and Earth.

In PSHE this week we have been sharing our knowledge about how to be a friend. We have been talking about what is a good secret to keep and what isn't.
