Learning Journey: All the World's a Stage!

Our Learning Journey

This week we have been planning and writing a diary entry from the point of view of one of the main characters from A Midsummers Night Dream. We have been using our empathy goggles and inference skills to imagine how they would be feeling at different points in the story. We have been using a wide range of conjunctions including as, if, when, that and also trying to extend our sentences with that, which who or with.

In drama sessions we have been using 'Magic canvass' and 'Sound scaping' to develop a sense of the setting and using all our senses when describing. These are techniques passed on by the Globe Theatre to help bring the text to life.

Example:	I can remember to:
$46 - 23 = ?$	1. Write down the biggest number first
$46 - 20 = 26$	2. Partition the second number into tens and ones
$26 - 3 = 23$	3. Subtract the tens from the first number , use a hundred square to help
	4. Subtract the ones from my previous result.

In maths we have revisited subtraction starting with subtracting two two digit numbers by using the method shown.

We moved on to subtracting on a number line with some children using the inverse to work on missing number problems.
