



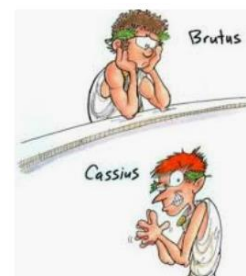

Learning Journey: All the World's a Stage!

Our Learning Journey

- In literacy this week we have been continuing to read Julius Caesar. We have been writing letters in the role of one of the characters and thinking about how conflicted the character is feeling.
- We have also acted out a scene from the book to help us when we write our report about Caesar's assassination.
- In maths we are learning to use the formal written method for addition, where we are 'carrying over' tens and hundreds. We have also been adding 2 two-digit numbers to total 100.
- We have been finding out about Roman roads in history and have named some of the Roman roads in Britain. We also named the cities that they linked.



Home Learning

- We have a new learning log this week and we would like the children to research the Celts in Britain. They could find out about how they lived, what clothes they wore, any famous Celts or any other interesting information that they can find. They can record their information in pictures, diagrams or writing.
- All children are expected to read at least 20 minutes a day.
- Please encourage them to read with you and engage them by asking questions about the text.
- Year 3 have been given new spellings - please complete the sheets and the activity on the back.
- Children will need to practice their times tables and link the facts to division facts
