Learning Journey: All the World's a Stage!

Our Learning Journey

“Speak child,” Lear prompted.

To which Cordelia replied, “Nothing my Lord.”

“Say nothing and you will receive nothing,” roared Lear in reply.

What would you do if your child didn't answer your question, “Who does love me the most?” Would you banish them? That's the event we've been exploring in *King Lear* ready to spring off into the next part of the story. As you can see, we've been looking at direct speech. Ask your child about the punctuation and maybe write some dialogue with them.

In maths, we've focussed on dividing through the formal method. For an idea of the method try googling “short division with remainders” by “Let's do Math” on YouTube.

Home Learning

Please focus on using TTRockstars this week and follow the instructions below. When we were dividing this week, many children showed that they still aren't as secure in their times tables as they could be.

March - 15 minutes 2 to 3 times a week in Garage. If they're on Auto, they should aim to have passed level 365 by the end of the month.

April – At least, 20 games a week in Garage..

May - 10 minutes in Studio and 5 minutes 3-4 times a week in Soundcheck, which is our simulator for the end of year times-tables check.

June - 3 games per day in Soundcheck..

Please read 20 minutes a day, and ask how the characters change in the story and why.... Make sure your child gives you evidence from the story.
