Things that are not acceptable

Children like to test boundaries especially as they get older. However, it is important to remember that they are children and not young adults so should not be mimicking their older brothers and sisters in dress and style.

The following list sets out what we consider inappropriate for Dulwich Wood. To avoid phone calls from our Pastoral Team asking you to remedy the situation, please ensure that your child is neatly turned out and does not display any of the following:

Hair:	Dyed hair / hair extensions
Shirts:	White shirts
Tights:	Non uniform colours and patterned tights
Skirts:	Worn above the knee
Trousers:	Worn hanging down at the back Pupils wearing jogging bottoms instead of trousers
Trainers:	The same trainers being worn in PE and in class Non-black trainers outside of PE Trainers that are more non black than black due to stripes and logos
Jewellery:	Rings, piercings, necklaces. No jewellery shall be worn by pupils except for silver or gold stud earrings where ears have been pierced. If you are going to have your child's ears pierced please do it at the start of the summer holidays so their ears are healed by the time they return to school.
Handbags:	These are unnecessary as girls of primary age have a school bag to carry books and do not need a handbag to carry makeup as this is not allowed to be worn.
Nail varnish:	No nail varnish. If it is worn at the weekend it must be removed for school.
Makeup:	No make up
Tattoos:	Temporary tattoos must be fully removed before a child returns to school
Coats:	Coats that have metal studs in Coats with inappropriate slogans
